RULES FOR PARKING

All Morrison Center Volunteers will receive a Parking Pass for use from August 1st to July 31st each season.

The Parking Pass is valid <u>only</u> when working as a Volunteer for Morrison Center events.

Place your Parking Pass on driver's side windshield to be visible to BSU parking staff.

If BSU parking staff are present then stop, be courteous and obey their directions.

Always use your Parking Pass when working at the Morrison Center and **only** park in approved areas. If you do not, you may be liable for a parking fine from the Boise State Parking Services.

There are spaces for volunteers in the Morrison Center (MC) lot behind the loading bay/stage door area. These spaces are shared with other performance staff and are available first come first served. If this area is full, or closed for a performance, you must park in the Brady Garage, or on the Capitol Village surface lot.

A shuttle from the Brady Garage to the MC will be available for 20 minutes before call time, after intermission (by request), and at the end of the show (patrons have priority).

DO NOT park on the West Reserve surface lot (between the MC lot and the Brady Garage) – This area is reserved for patrons only.


If you have a disability license plate or placard you may use any ADA or metered parking space, and may also park in the ADA area reserved for patrons.

TIPS FOR PARKING LOT SAFETY

Parking lots can present risk of personal injuries and property damage. Members of The Morrison Center Volunteers should follow these guidelines to help maintain a high level of safety:

- Make sure to park in adequately illuminated spaces. Burnt-out light bulbs should be immediately reported to the Morrison Center staff.
- Watch your step to avoid tripping on trash and other debris.
- Be careful of slip hazards caused by pooled water and icing. During icy weather, it is a good idea to wear anti-slip-soled shoes.
- Be careful of water on walkways which creates a potential slip hazard.
- Avoid walking into potholes and deteriorated pavement.
- Watch for debris and landscaping materials getting onto walkways, creating slip and trip hazards.
- Walk with a buddy or ask for security staff to serve as an escort. Avoid walking to your vehicle late at night when no one else is around.

Document any accidents or incidents and report immediately to the Morrison Center staff.

You may need to show BSU parking staff your parking pass to gain admittance (space permitting).

If this area is full, or closed for a performance, you must park in the Brady Garage, or on the Capitol Village surface lot.

DO NOT park in the West Reserve Surface Lot.
