

RULES FOR PARKING

All Morrison Center Volunteers will receive a Parking Pass for use from August 1st to July 31st each season.

This Parking Pass is to be used only when you are working as a Volunteer for Morrison Center events.

You must place your Parking Pass on your driver's side windshield, so it is visible to parking staff. They will direct you to park in the designated area in the lot right behind the Morrison Center (available 3 hours prior to performance time), or if this lot is full (or closed for a performance), you may park in the West Reserve surface lot, or on the 3rd or 4th floor of the Brady Garage.

Please note that the section of the West Reserve lot between the Tower dormitories and the Fine Arts building is closed for events.

If you have a disability license plate or placard you may use any ADA or metered parking space.

You must always use your Parking Pass when working at the Morrison Center and park in the approved areas only. If you do not, you may be liable for a parking fine from the BSU Parking Services.

Document any accidents or incidents and report immediately to the Morrison Center staff.

TIPS FOR PARKING LOT SAFETY



Parking lots can present risk of personal injuries and property damage for organizations. Members of The Morrison Center Volunteers should follow these guidelines to help maintain a high level of safety:

- Make sure to park in adequately illuminated spaces. Burnt-out light bulbs should be immediately reported to the Morrison Center staff.
- Watch your step to avoid tripping on trash and other debris.
- Be careful of slip hazards caused by pooled water and icing. During icy weather, it is a good idea to wear anti-slip-soled shoes.
- Be careful of water on walkways which creates a potential slip hazard.
- Avoid walking into potholes and deteriorated pavement.
- Watch for debris and landscaping materials getting onto walkways, creating slip and trip hazards.

Morrison Center Volunteer Parking

There are 16 spaces available for volunteers to use in the parking lot adjacent to the rear of the Morrison Center.

This lot may be closed for some performances.

Volunteer parking is ONLY in the **highlighted** area.

You may need to show security staff your parking pass to gain admittance (space permitting).

If none of the highlighted areas are available, overflow parking is in the West Reserve surface parking lot between the Morrison Center and the Brady Garage, or on the 3rd and 4th floor of the Brady Parking Garage.
